## **Colusa County General Plan Update**

The Colusa County Board of Supervisors will be holding a **Public Meeting on Tuesday, June 15, 2010**, at 11:00 a.m., at the Board Chambers in the Historic Courthouse, at 547 Market Street, Colusa.

**The Colusa County General Plan Update consultants will be giving an Introductory Presentation to the Board of Supervisors regarding the Draft Issues and Opportunities Report, Fiscal and Traffic Studies, Background Report, and Land Use Alternative Maps.**

The Draft Issues and Options Report and Land Use Alternative Maps are to provide future direction as to how the County will develop over the next 20+ years. Land use decisions relating to housing, protection of agriculture, expansion of County road systems, development of recreation resources, and promotion of job creation into the County's future are all going to be affected by the decisions resulting from the General Plan Update work.

After June 7, 2010 the Draft Issues and Options Report, Fiscal and Traffic Studies, Background Report, and the Land Use Alternative Maps may be reviewed at the Department of Planning and Building, 220 – 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Colusa.
